Nutshell:

Songleader's notes:

When memorized by firelight, what better time to meditate on the presence of God, represented for millennia by the symbol of fire.

This is a musical take on the proclamation of John 1.4-5: "What came into being through the Word was life, the light for all people. This light shines in the darkness and the darkness does not overcome it."

Romans 8.38-39 also speaks to the overcoming nature of God's love.

How to lead it:

Sing it through twice, then invite the group to sing.

To sing it in canon, use two songleaders, each directing one group.


Try inventing hand actions or using American Sign Language.


